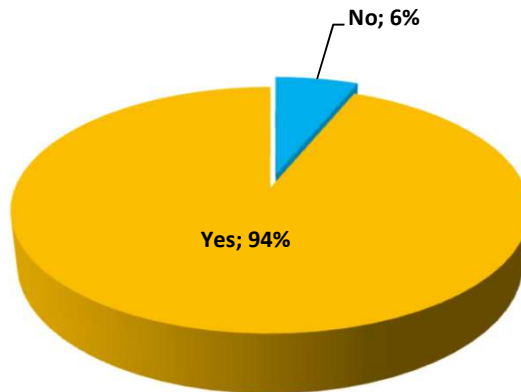

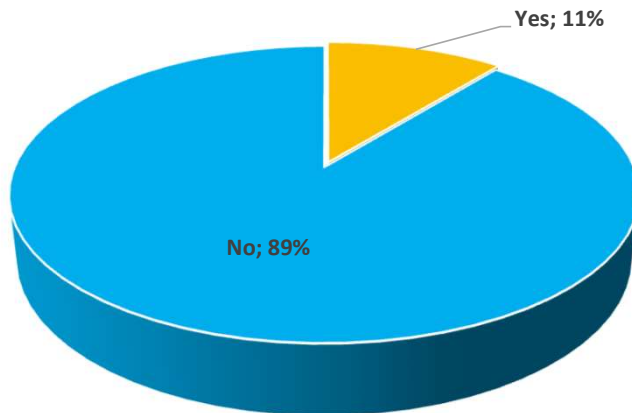

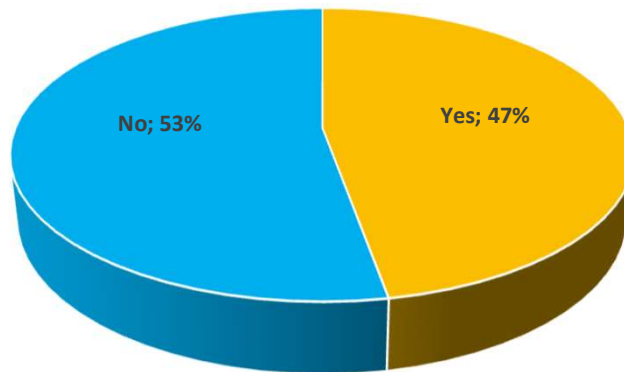

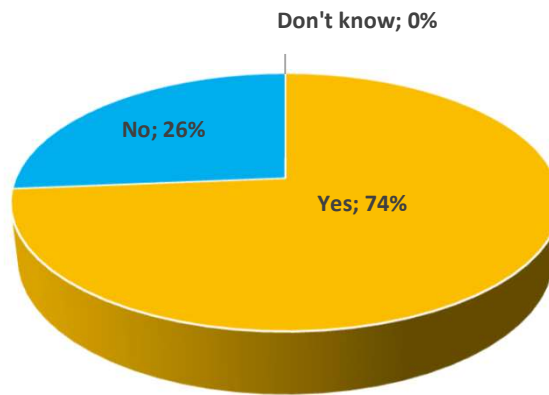


Has the way you work been influenced by new research?

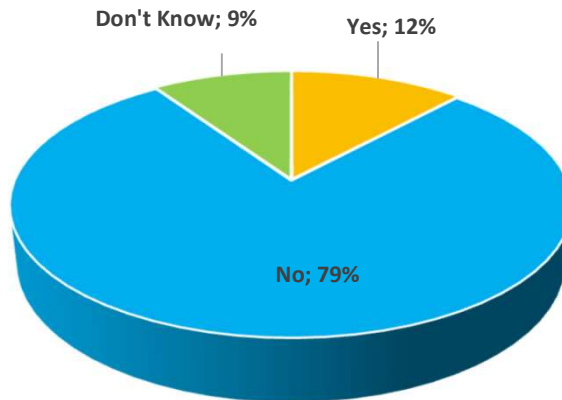

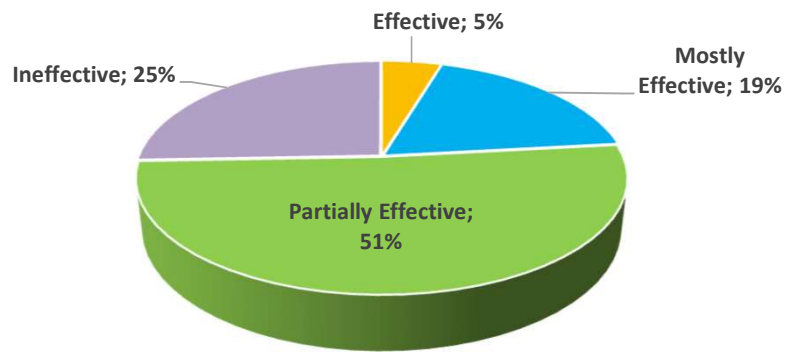


Given the significance of process approach, do you believe that your business is adequately process mapped, and understands its interactions? (42 responses)

**Dame Judith Hackitt has said she was “truly shocked” by standards in the construction industry when researching her report, *Independent Review of Building Regulations and Fire Safety*, published earlier this year.**

**She said,**

What we are calling for is collaboration and joined-up thinking across the built environment sector, not self-interested groups protecting their own turf, something I have seen a lot of."
